Cambridge College launches Master of Management Program in Worcester

WORCESTER— Cambridge College is linking up with the City of Worcester to offer the **Master of Management AdaptNet Program, beginning November 10th**. The AdaptNet program will offer full- time working professionals a chance to enhance their education through online coursework and a monthly weekend class at the **Crowne Plaza Hotel at 10 Lincoln Square in downtown Worcester.**

In the AdaptNet program—which was recently awarded the United States Distance Learning Association’s (USDLA) Best Practices Platinum Award for Online Distance Learning Programming—the student experiences face-to-face instruction with highly qualified faculty by attending intensive weekend sessions once a month for three to four terms, while independently completing additional online adaptive sessions. The Master of Management program offers the student a customized learning experience by catering to the schedule of a working professional and adapting to the individual learning style of each individual.

“We experienced extremely high completion rates of 91% when we first offered the Master of Management Program in Springfield,” said Dr. Nish Sonwalkar, Vice President of Cambridge College’s Center for Adaptive Learning and Programs. “Our findings were very rewarding and we expect to have the same results in Worcester this semester.”
