Cambridge College opens new Alden Trust Lab

CAMBRIDGE—Cambridge College’s first science lab is now open for business. On Wednesday, October 16th, the College inaugurated the George I. Alden Trust Laboratory at Cambridge College in Room 242 at 1000 Massachusetts Ave in Cambridge.

The ceremony began when Associate Dean of the Undergraduate Program Dr. James Lee, Chancellor Eileen Moran Brown, President Mahesh Sharma, Trustee Janet Whitla, and green chemistry professor Dr. Amy Cannon cut the ribbon and welcomed members of the Cambridge College community to the new facility. Dr. Lee presented an overview of the technologically advanced equipment in the room, while Dr. Cannon spoke briefly about the College’s developing green chemistry program.

President Sharma said that the College’s mission to offer a well-rounded education can be truly fulfilled, as the school is now able to offer a comprehensive education in all four of the main academic areas with the addition of this lab. He then added, “This marks the beginning of our quest to produce a Nobel laureate!”
