Students and professionals from all over the Greater Boston area will join the Cambridge College community on November 30th, from 5:30 pm to 8:30 pm in welcoming Jeanette G. Clough, CEO of Mount Auburn Hospital, to the School of Management Colloquium at 1000 Massachusetts Avenue in Cambridge.

Clough began her career as a staff nurse and clinical nurse specialist at Massachusetts General Hospital. After obtaining a Master's degree in Health Administration from Suffolk University, she went on to hold executive positions, including President and CEO of Deaconess Waltham Hospital, COO of WalWest Health Systems, Inc. and Vice President for Patient Care at Waltham Weston Hospital & Medical Center.

Community leader Carl F. Barron (founder of Putnam Furniture Store) will open the colloquium with an introduction for Clough. Barron is an advocate for the School of Management at Cambridge College and also helped fund the Barron Center for Men's Health at Mount Auburn Hospital.

Clough will visit Cambridge College Tuesday, November 30th to speak to students and the invited community about strategy and leadership.
