

NITE student use of Gutman Library at the Harvard Graduate School of Education

Gutman Library is a special library in education with some related counseling materials. The library focuses on educational administration and policy, elementary and secondary education, teachers and teaching, educational innovations, educational psychology, human development, language acquisition, history of education, and selected subject areas related to education in the US and other English-speaking countries. Collections include ERIC microfiche, historical textbooks, and the Action for Children's Television Collection

NITE students are welcome to use and borrow books from Gutman Library at the Harvard Graduate School of Education, but you need to know that:

- 1) NITE students will have borrowing privileges at Emmanuel College Library, and will have access, but not borrowing privileges, at several nearby college libraries in the Fenway Libraries system (see <http://flo.org/> for a list), so you may not need to go to Gutman Library.
- 2) Getting to Gutman Library from Emmanuel College will take about 40 minutes on the subway and cost \$3.40 round trip. Parking near Gutman is difficult to find and very expensive.
- 3) You DO NOT need a special card **to enter and use** Gutman Library. You must show your NITE/Emmanuel College or Cambridge College ID card to enter Gutman Library.
- 3) You DO need a special card to **borrow** books from Gutman Library. Books must be returned by the end of the NITE residency.

If you expect to borrow books you will need a "Borrowers Card" from Gutman Library. It takes one month to process the card, so you should **start the process no later than May 15** so as to be sure to receive the card before you leave your home address for Boston.
