All you need is a public library card number which you can apply for online or in person. If your state is not listed, go to your local public library site or ask your local public librarian.

A collection of Economics, Business, Marketing, and Law journals with a scattering of political science, public affairs, science/technology, and humanities titles. NOTE: BEPress uses a "quasi-open access" model where users are required to fill out a guest form identifying their local library, which then gets subscription information. BEPress journals are searchable through [ResearchNow](#).

A subscription is only required to read articles from premium publications and business news sources and to take advantage of advanced functionality like Search Alerts, Public Alerts and user preferences.
