EgloбалSearch searches our major full-text databases, including

Medline with Full-Text is the world's most comprehensive source of full text for medical journals, providing full text for nearly 1,200 journals indexed in *MEDLINE*. Of those, more than 1,000 have cover-to-cover indexing in *MEDLINE*. With more than 1,400,000 full-text articles dating back to 1965, *MEDLINE with Full Text* is the definitive research tool for medical literature.

In the **Wilson Select Plus** database

- a search for the keywords "health care management" brought up full-text 4524 journal articles
- 41 full-text journals have "health" in the title, including journals on management, law, and public policy

Academic Search Premier has full-text of many health/medical journals including *Nursing Economics*; *Journal for Healthcare Design and Development*; *Hospital Law Newsletter*; *Hospital Development*

Electronic Books Of the 35,000+ online full-text books (as of 2006):

- 100+ books have "health care" in the title
- 598+ books have "health" in the title
- 30+ have "health" and "management" as subjects

But egloбалSearch does not search all of our health and medical databases!

To use all the health/medical databases, after doing an egloбалSearch, be sure to

- click the EBSCOHost icon on the CCOL HOME page
- on the EBSCOHost "Choose Databases" page be sure to check all relevant databases, including:
 - Academic Search Premier (**always keep this one checked to get full-text from the other databases!**)
 - Business Source Premier has 59 journals of health care management, almost all in Full-text
 - Health Source: Nursing/Academic Edition has 58 journals covering management issues
 - MEDLINE with Full-Text has 197 journals covering management
 - MEDLINE Select has 7 full-text journals covering management
 - Education Research Complete has seven journals related to health care
 - Clinical Pharmacology has drug information
 - PsycInfo
 - PsycBooks
 - PsycExtra
