Purchasing Used Textbooks

Make sure you have the correct title, author, publisher, year, and edition. To be sure, ask the professor for the ISBN number, which is the barcode number on the book’s cover. Every new edition will have a new barcode number.

Used textbooks may not be the most recent edition, but the older edition may not be substantially different. Ask your professor if an older edition is acceptable. Warning: The page numbers might not be the same. If the book has quizzes, problems, or questions, these may not be the same. Try to compare with a newer edition owned by a classmate.

Many of these sites will also buy the book back, so make sure you keep it in the best condition possible and do not write in it with pen, pencil, or markers.

Some sites offer free shipping.

Places to buy used textbooks:

Rental of physical textbooks

Warning!

- Compare prices
- Read the “Terms and Conditions” – yes, the small print!
- Don’t lose the book, you’ll have to pay for both the book and the rental
- Return it on time. Late fees can be expensive
- Don’t write in, highlight, mark up, or damage the book
