

Cambridge College Online

The mission of CC Online is to provide online educational opportunities of the highest quality in support of the Cambridge College mission and vision. Cambridge College began offering online courses in 2000. Since the first courses launched, over 24,000 students have participated in at least one online course. The College offers many fully online courses each term as well as five fully online degree programs.

Online and Hybrid Courses

Each school includes online and hybrid courses as part of its course offerings each term. Online courses are those courses that are offered exclusively online; there are no requirements to attend any sessions on any campus. Hybrid courses include on campus meetings as well as online components. Online and hybrid courses are typically the same length as the term in which they are offered (Fall/Spring, 14-15 weeks; Summer 8-9 weeks); however, some may be offered in a shorter time span. Students may select online and/or hybrid courses to complete their degree requirements in all programs. International students are restricted to registering for just one online course each term.

Fully Online Degree Programs

Admission

Students may apply at any time for admission into an online degree program. Course starts occur five times during the calendar year. Admission requirements are the same for each level of education. See the *School of Undergraduate Studies Admission Requirements* and *School of Management Admission Requirements* for the MBA programs.

Academic Advising

Academic advising for fully online degree seeking students is available through the Advising Office – Online Program Advisor. This office may be reached at 1-877-434-4997. Office hours are typically Monday through Friday, 10 AM to 6 PM.

Faculty/Program Advisor

Students will be assigned an advisor through the program in which they are enrolled. These individuals are available to assist with academic planning and career development.

Degree Programs

The following programs are available 100% online:

Undergraduate Degree Programs

- Bachelor of Science, Management Studies
- Bachelor of Science, Health Care Management
- Bachelor of Science, Managerial Accounting

Graduate Degree Programs

- Master of Business Administration
- Master of Business Administration, Health Care Management

Courses for fully online degree programs are 8-weeks in length, with two sessions scheduled in the Fall term, two sessions in the Spring term, and one session in the Summer term.

Student Support

Small online classes offer personalized attention for each student, allowing students to communicate with faculty via phone, Zoom, or email as needed. Students taking online courses or enrolled in a fully online degree program have access to a support network that includes the following:

TutorMe
