Cambridge College students are invited to apply for one or more of the following scholarships. To be considered, applicants must meet general eligibility requirements along with the eligibility criteria of each scholarship for which they apply. Please see page 3 for requirements.

### General Eligibility Requirements

#### All applicants must:

- Complete the 2013-2014 FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) unless otherwise noted in the eligibility criteria of a scholarship.
- Be planning on attending Cambridge College during the 2013-2014 academic year.
- Be matriculated and enrolled that semester (unless otherwise noted in the eligibility criteria of a scholarship).
- Have no NCI notations on their transcripts at the time of the scholarship committee review (INC grades will be reviewed by the committee on a case-by-case basis).
- Have no outstanding balance with Cambridge College from a prior semester.
- Be within the financial aid satisfactory academic progress (SAP) guidelines.

### Specific Eligibility Criteria

Please read the criteria for each scholarship/award; see page 3. You must meet the eligibility criteria for **each** of the scholarships for which you apply. Only college-level courses (numbered 100 and above) taken at Cambridge College up to and including the prior semester for which the scholarship would be awarded, and applicable toward a degree or certificate program will be considered when determining the minimum number of required course credits and grade point average.

Submit a one-page typed statement addressing **ONE** of the topics below and any additional information required for a specific scholarship you have checked above.

#### Topics for 2013-2014 academic year:

1. Describe an area of your life in which you played a leadership role (community activities, family or employment responsibilities, college activities, etc.) and any related honors or awards that you have received.
2. Describe a situation where you had significant responsibility and what you learned from the situation.
3. Describe your strengths and weaknesses in a) setting and achieving goals, and in b) working with other people.
4. What has been the greatest challenge you have faced so far in your life?
5. What do you hope to accomplish with your degree from Cambridge College and how will scholarship funds help you?
6. Share a unique story about your life situation that you would like the scholarship committee to know in reviewing your application.

Your personal statement should only be one page, typed using a 12-point font. Please include your name on your statement. Make sure you clearly state which topic you are addressing. Whichever topic you choose, please include some autobiographical details as well as some background on what led you to choose Cambridge College and what your experience here has been like so far. Please feel free to give your personal statement a title.

## 2013-2014 Scholarships and Eligibility Criteria

### Carl F. Barron Scholars

**Eligibility:** Awarded to undergraduates with a GPA of at least 2.75 and graduate students with a GPA of 3.0. Scholastic record and financial need will be considered when awarding this scholarship.

**Additional documentation:** Written endorsement from a Cambridge College faculty member and an additional essay describing your personal goals. (New transfer students may submit an endorsement from a faculty member from their prior institution.)

### Henry Hampton Scholarship

**Eligibility:** Awarded to students (particularly African American students) who demonstrate in their personal and professional work, the tenets of civil rights for all groups and individuals.

**Additional documentation:** Additional essay that addresses the eligibility requirements and a letter of reference from an individual or organization who can attest to your work performed in the civil rights area.

### Anne W. Hiatt Scholars

**Eligibility:** Awarded to students from the Southeast Asian national of Vietnam, Cambodia, Laos and Burma who demonstrate outstanding dedication to achieving their educational goals and to creating a better society.

**Additional documentation:** Documentation verifying that you or your parents are from one of the eligible countries (certificate of US nationalization or a foreign passport), in addition to the personal statement, provide a statement addressing your dedication to achieving your goals and creating a better society.

### Stacy Milgrim Scholarship Fund

**Eligibility:** Awarded to students who are attempting to make a life or career change through education, and who are also handling difficult family problems as they complete their educational program.

**Additional documentation:** n/a

### St. Mary's Women and Children Center —Frances A. Keith Scholarship

**Eligibility:** Awarded to students with financial need who are or were a client, resident, student or child of a client, resident or student of an employee of St. Mary's Women and Children's Center, Inc. Candidates are identified by St. Mary's Women and Children's Center.

**Additional documentation:** n/a

### Henry Francis Barrow Scholarship Fund

**Eligibility:** Awarded to Protestant men, giving preference to graduates of Boston and Greater Boston public schools.

**Additional documentation:** Please note on the questionnaire section your religious affiliation.

### William Randolph Hearst Endowed Scholarship

**Eligibility:** Award to adult learners with demonstrated motivation and financial need. A student must have completed one semester and be in good academic standing to qualify.

**Additional documentation:** n/a

### Medical Interpreter Program Scholarship

**Eligibility:** Awarded to students in the Medical Interpreter Certificate Program (degree- and non-degree seeking) who demonstrate financial need.

**Additional documentation:** Students must submit a teacher recommendation from a professor within the program. Certificate students must also submit a written statement demonstrating their financial need, in lieu of the FAFSA.

### Jane Saltonstall Scholarship Endowment Fund

**Eligibility:** Awarded to women who are making steady progress toward the completion of a bachelor's or master's degree and who have experienced and overcome extraordinary personal challenges in their lives.

**Additional documentation:** In addition to the personal statement, provide a statement addressing the eligibility requirement above.
